## Medical Alert & Detection



Detect changes in the body before symptoms become dangerous.

- ✓ Blood sugar drops
- ✓ Seizure alerts
- ✓ Allergen detection (like gluten)

## Mobility Support



Assist with balance, walking, and physical stability

- ✓ Bracing
- ✓ Retrieving dropped items
- ✓ Opening doors

## Psychiatric Support



Interrupt and reduce the impact of mental health episodes

- ✓ Grounding during anxiety or PTSD
- ✓ Interrupting harmful behaviors
- ✓ Creating a physical space in overwhelming environments

## Safety & Awareness



Provide an extra layer of protection and awareness

- ✓ Alerting to sounds
- ✓ Guiding through crowds
- ✓ Helping navigate unfamiliar environments
